Regular punctual attendance at school is vital. We all want our children to get a great education, and the building blocks for a great education begin with coming to school each and every day. If children miss school regularly, they miss out on learning the fundamental skills that will set them up for success in their later years of school. There is no safe number of days for missing school - each day a child misses, puts them behind, and can affect their educational outcomes. Attendance patterns are established early. A child regularly missing days in the early years of school will often continue to miss classes in the later years, which can have significant negative consequences on their educational performance.
